APPROVAL OF CONTRACT

Charter Communications, Inc.

WHEREAS, the City of Selma, Alabama (*the "City"*) is the recipient of a \$400,000.00 Omnibus Appropriation through the Alabama Department of Transportation for the relocation of overhead utilities to underground in two blocks of Water Avenue; *and*

WHEREAS, Charter Communications, Inc. has reviewed the proposed scope of work and submitted a proposal to the City, and following careful review, along with a professional engineering firm, the City has chosen the option to have Charter Communications relocate approximately 1244 LF of aerial cable and approximately 740 LF of underground cable at a cost of \$15,677.40.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama that:

George Evans, in his capacity as Mayor, is hereby authorized to execute a contract in the amount of \$15,677.40 with Charter Communications, Inc., pending ALDOT approval, for relocation of overhead utilities to underground on Water Avenue; *and*

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED said contract expenses shall be reimbursable from the Alabama Department of Transportation.




