APPROVAL OF CONTRACT

Pine Belt Broadcasting, LLC

WHEREAS, the City of Selma, Alabama (*the "City"*) is the recipient of a \$400,000.00 Omnibus Appropriation through the Alabama Department of Transportation for the relocation of overhead utilities to underground in two blocks of Water Avenue; *and*

WHEREAS, Pine Belt Broadcasting, LLC has reviewed the proposed scope of work and submitted a proposal to the City, and following careful review, along with a professional engineering firm, the City has chosen the option to have Pine Belt tap into existing fiber on Washington Street and place new aerial fiber down Alabama Avenue across Broad Street to the alley behind the bank and down the alley to the back side of the present Pine Belt office location and tap into the existing fiber entering the building at a cost of \$15,174.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama that:

George Evans, in his capacity as Mayor, is hereby authorized to execute a contract in the amount of \$15,174.00 with Pine Belt Broadcasting, LLC, pending ALDOT approval, for relocation of overhead utilities located on Water Avenue; *and*

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED said contract expenses shall be reimbursable from the Alabama Department of Transportation.


