FY 2011/2012 AMERICORP GRANT

*Authorizing application for funding through
the Governor's Office of Faith-Based and Community Initiative*

WHEREAS, the City of Selma desires to apply to The Corporation for National & Community Service for a FY 2011/2012 competitive grant for the City of Selma Digital Divide Program which addresses computer literacy, citywide training and community educational initiatives; *and*

WHEREAS, the City of Selma possesses the legal authority to apply for said grant and execute the proposed program; *and*

WHEREAS, the application will be reviewed and grants awarded to localities rating the highest in the rating criteria; *and*

WHEREAS, the total cost of the project is \$475,337.00 and the maximum grant amount is \$266,142.00; *and*

WHEREAS, the City of Selma pledges to provide approximates 44% match (\$134,404.00 cash and \$74,792.00 in-kind) to be appropriated in the FY 2011 - 2012 budget.

NOW THEREFORE , BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The Selma City council hereby authorizes the filing of said application, including all understandings and assurances contained therein, and does hereby authorize and direct Mayor George P. Evans as the official representative of the applicant to act in connection with the application and to provide such information as may be required.


